I understand that the adjustment period could be anywhere from one month to six months; sometimes longer. I will be required, and are willing to spend a lot of time and energy training and exercising my new dog. I will teach my new dog if she/she fails to meet my expectations. I will seek professional help to train my new dog if needed. I will not expose my new dog to large numbers of new people, places or other animals until he/she has had the opportunity to become comfortable with his/her new environment, surroundings and family. I will give specific instructions to all new people entering our home as to how to interact with our new dog. I will properly introduce, in a controlled environment, our new dog to any new person entering the house. Weimaraners are extremely loyal dogs and can become extremely protective of their family and domain. The can also change over time and you must constantly work with your new dog to maintain proper behavior. Dogs are animals and can be unpredictable. I will be careful and patient.
